Part I:

- Box reference I.5: Registration number (railway wagons or container and lorries), flight number (aircraft) or name (ship); information is to be provided in the event of unloading and reloading.
- Box reference I 25: technical use: any use other than for animal consumption.
- Box reference 1.28; Species: select from the following: Aves, Ruminantia, Mammalia other than Ruminantia, Pesca, Mollusca, Crustacea, invertebrates other than Mollusca and Crustacea. In case of farmed fish or farmed insects specify its scientific name.
