**IV. HEALTH INFORMATION**

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that:

- (a) the petfood was made using Category 3 material in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 1069/2009 and manufactured using technologies and methods suitable for preventing the spread of infectious animal diseases;
- (b) the raw animal by-products used in the manufacture of the petfood:
  - are derived from healthy animals slaughtered in a licensed slaughterhouse which underwent ante- and post-mortem inspection and showed no clinical signs of diseases communicable to humans or animals;
  - do not contain harmful levels of toxins or residues;
- (c) the raw animal by-products derived from slaughtered animals used in the manufacture of the petfood have been heated to a minimum temperature of 133°C for at least 20 minutes at a pressure of at least 3 bar or to an equivalent treatment in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 142/2011;
- \* (d) dry petfood has been heated to a temperature of 95°C;
- \* (e) wet petfood has been heated to a F0 value of 3.0 or heated to a temperature of 120°C for 25 minutes at a pressure of 2 bars;
- (f) the processes used to manufacture the petfood are approved and subject to inspection by the competent veterinary authority of the country of manufacture;
- (g) all reasonable precautions have been taken before, during and after heat treatment to prevent contamination of the product prior to despatch;
- (h) dry petfood was packed in new packaging (boxes, bags);
- (i) on the basis of laboratory testing of samples of the petfood, the petfood is free of salmonella;
- (j) all the official records relating to the petfood have been kept on file at the manufacturing facility in order to demonstrate the above and are available for verification by the competent veterinary authority of the country of manufacture.
