V. ADDITIONAL DECLARATIONS REGARDING IMPORTED MATERIALS

I, the undersigned, certify that the products described in the accompanying Export Health Certificate, bearing the serial number as above, comply with the following requirements:

A) Processing Information

1. The fishery and aquaculture products specified above have been processed, packed and/or stored in a facility approved by Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (DEFRA) as complying with the requirements of the importing country;
2. The facility specified in the Export Health Certificate is subjected to regular inspection and audit to ensure that production, processing practices, quality control system and products, comply with the following:
 - a) Final salmonid products for export to Australia have been processed from raw salmonid materials imported exclusively from _____ and are subject to effective separation controls that ensure:
 - i. the prevention of inadvertent or deliberate substitution;
and
 - ii. the prevention of commingling with, or contamination by, aquatic animal material originating in countries other than those stated above.
 - b) Consignments of raw materials that are split and sent to different approved facilities for processing are effectively tracked and clearly indicate:
 - i. the total number of parts the original consignment is split into;
 - ii. the consecutive part number thereof; and
 - iii. its respective percentage of the total original consignment.

c) Movement of final salmonid products (intended for Australia) from processing premises to export facilities are effectively tracked;

B) Sourcing Attestations

1. The source country health certification that accompanied the raw salmonid materials further processed and exported in the United Kingdom has been checked to ensure that the materials originated from a country approved by Australia and originate from the lot indicated on the quoted dated and numbered source country health certificate from the Competent Authority of the source country;
