I, the undersigned official veterinarian, authorised thereto by the Veterinary Authority of the United Kingdom, certify the following with regards to the consignment described above:

- (a) the lanolin/lanolin derivative is sourced from a plant that is regularly inspected and approved for export by the veterinary authority;
- (b) the lanolin/lanolin derivative originates from wool from sheep only;
- (c) the lanolin/lanolin derivative was heated to a temperature of not less than 60 °C for a continuous period of not less than 60 minutes, and poses no risk of introducing rinderpest, foot and mouth disease, peste de petits ruminants and sheep and goat pox into South Africa;
- (d) the leak-proof drums were filled directly from the processing unit and the lanolin/lanolin derivative did not come into contact with raw material or any other source of contamination;
- (e) the product is shipped in leak-proof drums in a container that has been sealed under official supervision.
