- (b) the lanolin/lanolin derivative originates from wool from sheep only;
- (c) the landlin/landlin derivative was heated to a temperature of not less than 60 °C for a continuous period of not less than 60 minutes, and poses no risk of introducing rinderpest, foot and mouth disease, peste de petits ruminants and sheep and goat pox into South Africa;
- (d) the leak-proof drums were filled directly from the processing unit and the lanolin/lanolin derivative did not come into contact with raw material or any other source of contamination;
- (e) the product is shipped in leak-proof drums in a container that has been sealed under official supervision.
