- 1. that a declaration has been received from the exporter of the consignment described above stating that:
 - (a) the bovine material used to produce the Gelatin described at I overleaf was derived from bovine animals originating from:

 - (b) no other product of animal origin has been added during the further processing of Gelatin. Only chemicals, water and heat are used in the further processing of Gelatin;
 - (c) traceable records of raw materials for each batch of Gelatin are maintained and are available for inspection;
- 2. that the raw material from which this consignment of Gelatin has been produced does not contain any part of the skull and spinal cord, as defined in the Specified Risk Material Order (SRM) defined in European Commission Regulation 1494/2002 which amends Regulation 999/2001/EC;
- 3. that the bovine Gelatin has passed the de-caseinogens process by using alkaline process or acid alkaline process by passing temperature not less than 138 degree centigrade for 4 seconds minimum;
- 4. the products identified at I. overleaf are labelled or otherwise identified to show;
 - (a) the establishment of production;
 - (b) that the product was produced in accordance with Council Decision 98/256/EC (as amended);
 - (c) that the product is suitable for use in human food, animal feed, cosmetics, medical or pharmaceutical products.
