IV Health Information

- I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, certify that:
- 1. the products described at I(a) above:
 - contain processed animal proteins which were examined by random sampling of at least five samples from each processed batch taken during storage at the processing plant, and the results of laboratory testing of these samples comply with the following:

Salmonella: absence in 25 g; n=5,c=0, n=0,M=0, Enterobacteriaceae: n=5,c=2, m=10, M=3 x10² in 1g;

- (b) contain processed animal protein and, in accordance with Regulation 999/2001 (as amended), cannot be fed to farmed animals which are kept, fattened or bred for the production of food;
- 2. all reasonable precautions have been taken to prevent contamination of the consignment subsequent to processing;
- 3. the end products were:
 - (a) stored only in enclosed storage;
 - (b) packed in new packaging material; or

in case of dispatch as bulk transport, containers or any other means of transport were thoroughly cleaned and disinfected with an approved disinfectant before use.

c =	unsatisfactory if the number of bacteria in one or more sample units is M or more: number of sample units the bacterial count of which may be between m and M, the sample still being considered acceptable if the bacterial count of the other sample units is m or less.
