- I, the undersigned veterinarian, certify that the products described above:

 (a) has been prepared in a processing plant approved and supervised by the competent authority in accordance with EC-legislation.
 - (b) has been prepared exclusively from the following animal byproducts:
 - i Parts of animals of avian/porcine origin, excluding bristles:
 - that have been slaughtered in an authorised slaughterhouse;
 - that underwent ante-mortem inspection and were found suitable, as a result of such inspection, for human consumption;
 - that were not affected by any signs of diseases communicable to humans or animals;
 - (c) has been subjected to heating to a core temperature of more than 133°Celsius for at least 20 minutes without interruption at a pressure (absolute) of at least 3 bar produced by saturated steam, with a particle size prior to processing of not more than 50 millimetres or processed by an officially approved alternative system of heat treatment offering equivalent guarantee with regard to microbiological safety;
 - (d) the end product:
 - was packed in new or sterilised bags;
 - was transported in bulk, in containers or other means of transport that was thoroughly cleaned and disinfected with a disinfectant approved by the competent authority before use;
 - (e) does not contain any ruminant material;
 - (f) the end product was stored in enclosed storage;
 - (g) has undergone all precautions to avoid contamination with pathogenic agents after treatment;

- (h) is suitable for direct use as feed material or other use in feeding stuffs for pets, blood meal however can be used as fish feed;
- (i) that the area from which the product is exported is free from the following diseases to which the species is susceptible:

foot and mouth disease, vesicular stomatitis, swine vesicular disease, African swine fever, classical swine fever, avian influenza and Newcastle disease.

(j) that the processed animal protein is produced from raw materials that do not contain any risk to the health of humans or animals;
