 - (1)either [- carcases and parts of animals slaughtered and which are fit for human consumption, but are not intended for human consumption for commercial reasons;]
 - (1) and/or [- carcases and parts originating from animals that have been slaughtered in a slaughterhouse and were considered fit for slaughter for human consumption following an ante-mortem inspection:

Part I:
