JUDGMENT

1. The claim of a failure to pay notice pay succeeds. Therefore, the Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant by way of damages the net sum of $\pounds 3,127.75$.

2. The claim of an unlawful deduction from wages in respect of holiday pay also succeeds and the Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant the sum of £355.36.

3. In total, therefore, the Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant the sum of £3,483.11.
