2. Anthrax

was either:

3. Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD)

- (a) *Either:
 - i. has originated in the territory of a country or zone acknowledged by the Office International des Epizooties as being free of foot-and-mouth disease;

*Or:

ii. originates from herds or flocks which were not infected or suspected of being infected with FMD at the time of milk collection;

and:

- iii. has been processed to ensure the destruction of the FMD virus in conformity with standard procedures.
- (b) was subject to necessary precautions after processing to avoid contact of the products with any potential source of FMD virus;

4	Rinderpest

(a) *Either:

i. has originated in the territory of a country or zone
 acknowledged by the Office International des Epizooties
 as being free of rinderpest;

*Or:

ii. originates from herds or flocks which were not subject to any restrictions due to rinderpest at the time of milk collection;

and:

- iii. has been processed to ensure the destruction of the rinderpest virus in conformity with approved procedures.
- (b) was subject to necessary precautions after processing to avoid contact of the products with any potential source of rinderpest virus;

5. Bovine Tuberculosis:

Where derived from cattle, water buffaloes and/ or wood bisons, the milk used in producing this consignment

Either:

*a. has been derived from animals in a herd free from bovine Tuberculosis

Or:

*b. was subjected to pasteurization

or:

*c. was subjected to a combination of control measures with equivalent performance as described in The Codex Alimentarius Code of Hygienic Practice for Milk and Milk Products.
