## **JUDGMENT**

- 1. Pursuant to Rule 21 of the Employment Tribunal Rules of Procedure 2013:
  - a. The claim of unauthorised deduction from wages against the First Respondent is well-founded and succeeds. The First Respondent shall pay the Claimant £70 net.
  - b. It is declared that the Claimant is entitled to a redundancy payment from the First Respondent in the sum of £1200 (3 x 1 x £400 gross weekly pay).
  - c. The claim of breach of contract in respect of notice pay against the First Respondent is well-founded and succeeds. The First Respondent shall pay the Claimant £1523.70 net (contractual entitlement 4 weeks x net weekly pay £380.92).
  - d. The claim of unfair dismissal against the First Respondent is well-founded and succeeds. The First Respondent shall pay the Claimant a compensatory award of £761.84 (one week's net loss of wages + compensation for loss of statutory rights in the sum of one week's pay).
- 2. The Claimant's claims against the Second Respondent are stayed.
