- (b) the meat and meat derivatives used in the manufacture of the pet food were obtained from slaughtered animals which did not show any signs of disease communicable through the material to humans or animals;
- *(c) in the case of canned pet food, the pet food has been subjected to heat treatment to a minimum Fc value of 3;
- *(d) in the case of processed pet food other than canned pet food:
- (i) the pet food has been manufactured using ingredients of animal origin which have been subjected to a treatment equivalent to a heat treatment of at least 90°C throughout their substance;
- (ii) the production process has been tested, with satisfactory results, for the presence of salmonellae and enterobacteriaceae;
- (e) all reasonable precautions have been taken to avoid contamination by pathogenic agents after processing.
