Summary of Binary and Frequency Changes

- 1. The Authority has agreed two contract variations with CRCs associated with the frequency and binary measures of re-offending. This note summarises those changes by CRC.
- 2. Where agreed, the frequency baseline is being changed from 2011 to the average of Contract Year 2.
- 3. Where agreed, an adjustment is being made to the binary measure to reflect the change in data source that occurred between the 2011 baseline being established and the operation of the payment by result mechanism. This adjustment will lower the binary measure by 0.44 percentage points. A more detailed explanation of this adjustment can be found in the technical note, 'PbR binary adjustment due to data source change'.
- 4. The changes by CRCs are summarised in the table below.
