**FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 REQUEST REF: FOI 0476-18**

Thank you for your email of 25 April 2018 asking for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000. You asked:

*Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I am requesting the following information related to ministerial vehicles which are used for your department.*

*I would be grateful if you would provide the following;*

- 1. The number of ministerial vehicles allocated to your department*
- 2. The make and model of each vehicle (i.e. Jaguar XF)*
- 3. Month and year of first registration for each vehicle*
- 4. Fuel type for each vehicle*
- 5. CO2 emissions as referenced on the V5c for each vehicle*
- 6. Planned date of replacement for each vehicle*
- 7. The number of EV charging points at the departments location(s)*

The FCO has a contract with FCO Services to provide a service for the transportation of ministers and the fleet in which to carry out this service. In light of this your request has been passed to FCO Services for completion.

I am writing to confirm that we have now completed the search for the information which you requested. I can confirm that FCO Services does hold information relevant to your request.

FCO Services provides the London Car Service to the FCO and other Whitehall departments. The London Car Service is a service for transporting ministers and senior members of staff when public transport cannot be used.
