Thank you for your query through the British Army website of 16 January 2018 requesting the following information:

"Can you please provide me with details of any contracts Carillion has to provide services at Victoria Barracks or Comberemere Barracks in Windsor"

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD) and I can confirm that all the information in scope of your request is held.

I can confirm that no contracts are provided by Carillion.

Under Section 16 of the Act (Advice and Assistance) you may find it helpful to note that there are no contracts solely with Carillion but there are joint venture contracts with Carillion. These are:

SOUTH EAST REGIONAL PRIME CONTRACT	Carillion Amey Ltd	Start - 01/02/2015	End - 31/01/2020
South East Region Multi-Activity Contract	CarillionAramark Limited	Start - 03/03/2017	End - 31/08/2022

The South East Regional Prime contract covers Hard Facilities Management services and the South East Region Multi-Activity Contract covers Soft Facilities Management services.

Companies involved in a joint venture contract must fulfil the requirements of the entire contract should their partner company be unable to do so.
