

## NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MODIFY PUBLIC PATH ORDERS

### HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 SECTIONS 26 AND 119

Notice is hereby given pursuant to paragraph 2(3) of Schedule 6 to the Highways Act 1980 that the Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs to determine the Lincolnshire County Council Public Path Creation Order 2017 Public Footpath No. 1108 Market Deeping & Deeping St James, and Public Path Extinguishment Order 2017 Parts of Public Footpath Number 4 Market Deeping and Deeping St James, proposes to modify these Orders by providing for the following modifications:

Public Path Creation Order 2017 Public Footpath No. 1108 Market Deeping & Deeping St James:

- Delete "28" from the first line of paragraph 1 in the Order and insert "90".
- Delete from the eighth line of the first description in the Order Schedule, "TF 1405 1507" and insert "TF 1405 1057".
- Delete from the sixth and seventh lines of the second description in the Order Schedule, "*where the footpath continues at a width of 1.7 metres*" and insert "*where the footpath continues on a tarmac surface with a width of 2 metres*".

Public Path Extinguishment Order 2017 Parts of Public Footpath Number 4 Market Deeping and Deeping St James:

- Delete "*East Lindsey District Council*" from the second paragraph in the Order and insert "*South Kesteven District Council*".
- Delete "28" from the fourth line of paragraph 1 in the Order and insert "90".

- Insert a reference to the “*whole width*” for the sections of footpath to be extinguished.
