## JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant contributed to his dismissal by 50% so the compensatory and basic award is reduced by this amount.
- 2. There is no reduction under Polkey.
- 3. There is no uplift under Section 207A of the Trade Union and Labour Relations Act.
- 4. The claimant is entitled to one month's notice pay.
- 5. The claimant failed to mitigate his loss for the period up to 30 May when he first applied for a job. No compensatory award is payable after 31 October.
- 6. I award to the claimant the following:
  - 6.1. Notice pay of £1,534;
  - 6.2. Basic award, after 50% deduction for contributory fault, £767;
  - 6.3. Compensatory award of 5 month's net pay, after 50% deduction for contributory fault, £3,835

6.4. Loss of statutory rights, £350.

7. The total payable by the respondent to the claimant is £6,486.
