Thank you for your email of 18 June 2018 requesting the following information:

"I have submitted the following

1. Freedom of information request to DIO to ascertain the age of household furnishing and equipment. And to establish if Carillion Amey received any funds as part of the previous occupants move out."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD) and I can confirm that some the information in scope of your request is held.

Please find listed below the age of household furnishing and equipment:

Floor Coverings

Bedrooms 1 and 3 – Installed in 2014 Bedroom 2 – Installed in 2008 Hall, Stairs and Landing – 2018 Vinyl -- 2015

Curtains

Have been in the property for 10 years plus.

Redecoration

A full redecoration of the property was completed in 2014 and some walls in the lounge and bedrooms 1 and 3 were repainted in 2015.

Kitchen

Installation date is not known.

Bathroom

Installation date is not known.

Smoke/CO Alarms

The last gas certificate states that these items are due to expire in 2019.

In regards to your question of whether CarillionAmey received any funds as part of the previous occupants move out, I can confirm that Section 40(2) has been applied to this information in order to protect personal information as governed by the Data Protection Act 2018. Section 40 is an absolute exemption and there is therefore no requirement to consider the public interest in making a decision to withhold the information.
