Thank you for your email dated 21 March 2018 to the Ministry of Defence (MOD) in which you requested the following information:

I would be grateful if you provided the following information please.

- 1. Which trade union(s) are 'recognised' within your organisation?
- 2. How many members pay union subscriptions via DOCAS to the trade union(s)?
- 2. How many full-time equivalent posts are seconded to the trade union(s)?

For clarity, ACAS define a trade union as "recognised" by an employer when it negotiates agreements with employers on pay and other terms and conditions of employment on behalf of a group of workers.

If there is more than one union, please list the figures separately.

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOI Act). I can advise that following a search of our records, I have established that the MOD does hold information within the scope of your request.

The MOD officially recognises five trade unions which are the following;

Prospect PCS UNITE GMB FDA The MOD cease deducting from salary trade union subscriptions in February 2015.

In 2013 the MOD phased out all 100% facility time trade union reps.
