Thank you for your email of 25 June in which you requested the following information:

Commonwealth Soldiers from Saint Vincent and the Grenadines who enlisted in the Military from 2001. I would like to request under the Freedom of Information Act, a breakdown by year and ranks (OR and OF) of the number of Vincentians served and serving in the Armed Forces please.

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held and has been provided in the table below. Please note, the table is for Other Ranks only as there are no Officers recorded with Vincentian nationality. Some of the information falls entirely within the scope of the absolute exemption provided for at Section 40 (Personal Information) of the FOIA and has been withheld. Section 40(2) has been applied to some of the information in order to protect personal information as governed by the Data Protection Act.

If you have any queries regarding the content of this letter, please contact this office in the first instance. Following this, if you still wish to complain about the handling of your request, or the content of this response, you can request an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, Ground Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). There are no Officers recorded with a Vincentian nationality.

Nationality is that currently recorded, and not is necessarily the same as at birth or when recruited.

No nationality data is available for Royal Navy, Royal Marines and Royal Air Force prior to 2007.

Figures have been rounded to the nearest 5 to limit disclosure and ensure confidentiality. "~" denotes fewer than 5.
