Thank you for your email dated 1 February 2018 in which you requested the following information:

How many British Armed Forces personnel have been arrested under the Terrorism Act 2000 between 1st December 2016 and today's date. Furthermore, for each individual arrest, please include:

- The date the arrest took place
- The service branch to which the arrested personnel belonged
- The rank the arrested personnel held at the time of arrest

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOI Act).

I can advise you that following a search of our records, I have established that the Ministry of Defence (MOD) does hold information within the scope of your request.

I can confirm four Armed Forces (AF) personnel were arrested under the Terrorism Act 2000 during the time period stated. The arrests took place on 5 Sep 2017. The four AF personnel from the Army included two Privates (pte) and two Lance Corporals (LCpls).
