JUDGMENT ON REMEDY

1. The Claimant's claim of a failure to pay a redundancy payment succeeds and the Respondent is therefore ordered to pay to the Claimant the sum of $\pounds7,650$.

2. The Claimant's claim of a failure to pay notice pay also succeeds and pursuant to Section 86 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 the Respondent is ordered to pay damages to the Claimant in the sum of £3,600.

3. The Claimant's claim in respect of holiday pay also succeeds and the Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant the sum of £240.

4. The Respondent is therefore ordered in total to pay to the Claimant the sum of £11,490.
