The Carriage of Dangerous Goods and Marine Pollutants in Packaged Form: Amendment 39-18 to the International Maritime Dangerous Goods (IMDG) Code

Notice to all Owners, Ship Operators and Managers, Masters and Officers of Merchant Ships, Agents, Charterers, Cargo Packers, Cargo Consolidators, Hauliers, Freight Forwarders, Shippers, Consignors, Training Providers, Inspectors of Cargoes, Port Authorities and Terminal Operators and others involved in the transport of dangerous goods by sea.

This notice takes effect from 1st January 2019 and replaces MSN 1875 (M)

Summary

- This MSN is for the transport of dangerous goods and marine pollutants in packaged form by sea on ships within United Kingdom waters and on United Kingdom ships wherever they may be. The Merchant Shipping (Dangerous Goods and Marine Pollutants) Regulations 1997 and the Merchant Shipping (Vessel Traffic Monitoring and Reporting Requirements) Regulations 2004 are amended to incorporate the 39th Amendment to the IMDG Code in accordance with the internationally agreed date of 1 January 2020.
 - This Merchant Shipping Notice is an integral part of the above mentioned Merchant Shipping (Dangerous Goods and Marine Pollutants) Regulations 1997 and the Merchant Shipping (Vessel Traffic Monitoring and Reporting Requirements) Regulations 2004 as amended.

1. Introduction

1.1. All persons involved in the transport and preparation for transport of dangerous goods under the provisions of the IMDG Code must comply with the changes brought about by the amendment.



2. Transitional Arrangements

2.1. Amendment 39-18 to the International Maritime Dangerous Goods (IMDG) Code has been approved and adopted by the International Maritime Organization (IMO) and will enter into force internationally on 1 January 2019, with a twelve month "transitional period" until 31 December 2019.

2.2. From 1 January 2019 until 31 December 2019 dangerous goods and marine pollutants in packaged form shall be shipped either:

- in accordance with the mandatory IMDG Code 2016 Edition incorporating Amendment 38-16; or
- in accordance with the IMDG Code 2018 Edition incorporating Amendment 39-18.

3. Arrangements from 1 January 2020

3.1. From 1 January 2020 dangerous goods and marine pollutants in packaged form shall be shipped only in accordance with the IMDG Code 2018 Edition incorporating Amendment 39-18.

3.2. The final form of the 2018 Edition comprises two volumes. This edition of the Code incorporates changes made in UN Recommendations on the Transport of Dangerous Goods Model Regulations 20th revised edition.

3.3. The IMDG Code 2018 Edition incorporating Amendment 39 ((ISBN: 978-92-801-1682-3) (IMO Product Code is IL200E)) is available from the International Maritime Organization (IMO), 4 Albert Embankment, London SE1 7SR.

3.4. The Secretary of State considers the IMDG Code 2018 Edition incorporating Amendment 39-18 to be relevant for the purpose of the Merchant Shipping (Dangerous Goods and Marine Pollutants) Regulations 1997 and the Merchant Shipping (Vessel Traffic Monitoring and Reporting Requirements) Regulations 2004 as amended. Therefore, the Amendment shall take effect on 1 January 2019. Accordingly, references to the IMDG Code in those regulations on or after that date are construed as references to the Code as so amended.

4. Supplement

4.1. The supplement to the IMDG Code ((ISBN: 978-92-801-1683-0), (IMO Product Code is IJ210E)), gives the consequential amendments to the 2014 edition of the IMDG Code Supplement.
