"Could you please provide details of housing stock/quarters reserved for military personnel or civilians serving the military in the village of Walters Ash, Buckinghamshire.

Total quarters by quantity broken down by detached, semi detached and terrace or whatever way they are categorised but excluding accommodation blocks. Numbers in each defined category that, as on 30 June 2018, had been empty for 3 months, 6 months and 1 year."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD) and I can confirm that, all the information in scope of your request is held.
