Thank you for your email of 19 July in which you requested the following information:

a breakdown in numbers by Rank of Soldiers based in Scotland from how many Recruits up to rank of Majors etc based in Scotland.

A recent article by the MOD stated 8000 Soldiers based in Scotland but gives no breakdown on each specific rank.

If you can supply the breakdown by rank that would be great.

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000.

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held. The information you have requested can be found below. This has been interpreted as a request for Army information due to the references to 'soldiers' and the rank of 'Major'.

Section 40(2) (Personal Data) of the FOIA has been applied to some of the information in order to protect personal information as governed by the Data Protection Act 1998. Section 40 is an absolute exemption and there is therefore no requirement to consider the public interest in making a decision to withhold the information.

Please note:

- The data provided is for full time Army personnel, including Regulars, Gurkhas and Full Time Reserve Service.
- The figures are based on where individuals are stationed, not where they live. Not everyone stationed in Scotland is a Scottish taxpayer and not every Scottish taxpayer is stationed in Scotland.
- Personnel deployed on operations to an area away from their stationed location are shown against their most recent stationed location.
- Figures have been rounded to 10 to limit disclosure and ensure confidentiality.
