I refer to your e-mail dated 28 June 2018, which was acknowledged on 3 July 2018.

We are treating your e-mail as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your e-mail you requested the following information:

“The overtime spend from the last five financial years”

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.

The expenditure on overtime for the last five financial years is shown below. Please note that for accounting purposes the premium payments for working on public holidays are recorded as overtime costs. The information shown in the following table therefore provides a breakdown that shows the costs for casual overtime and unavoidable premium payments for working on public holidays:
