JUDGMENT

The Employer's Contract claim is struck out.

REASONS

1. By a letter dated **2 October 2018** the Tribunal gave the Claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, and to show cause as to why the Employer's Contract claim should not be struck out because:

- the Claimant had not complied with the Order of the Tribunal dated **22 August 2018**.
- The claim has not been actively pursued.

2. The Claimant has failed to make representations in writing why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The Employer's Contract claim is therefore struck out.
