JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant was unfairly dismissed.
- 2. The respondent did not discriminate against the claimant because of age.
- 3. The respondent did not breach the claimant's contract because it was contractually entitled to dismiss the claimant without giving notice.
- 4. Any compensatory award for unfair dismissal will be reduced to reflect the tribunal's finding that, had the respondent acted fairly, there is a 50% chance that the claimant would have remained employed by the respondent.
- 5. It is just and equitable to reduce the claimant's basic award of compensation by 50% to reflect the claimant's contributory conduct.
- 6. It would not be just and equitable to make any further reduction to the compensatory award to reflect the claimant's contributory conduct.
