Thank you for your email of 27 August requesting the following information:

“Please can you release full details of any in flight entertainment offered in the RAF Voyager used by the Prime Minister and Royal Family, as described in this news article:

For example, please could you provide a full list of films, television programmes, music (and so on) on any in-flight system. If the offered entertainment has changed over time, please could you include the dates in which different entertainment options were made available and removed.

If entertainment is provided by tablet devices that are not physically connected to the aircraft, like on some airlines, please treat this as part of the request. I want all information related to advice on answering FOI requests in the MOD”

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that the VIP Voyager does not offer or have any in-flight entertainment used by the Prime Minister or the Royal Family.
