JUDGMENT

The claim for a redundancy payment is struck out.

REASONS

- 1. The claimant claims a redundancy payment.
- 2. Section 155 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 requires a claimant to have not less than two years service to make such a claim.
- 3. The claimant was employed by the respondent for less than two years.
- 4. Therefore the claimant is not entitled to bring such a complaint.
- 5. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason, despite being given the opportunity to do so, why the claim for a redundancy payment should not be struck out.
- 6. Accordingly, the redundancy payment claim is struck out.
- 7. The claimant's other complaints are not affected by this judgment and remain listed for hearing on 3 December 2018.
