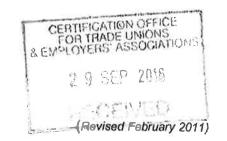

MEMBERS' STATEMENT

A member who is concerned that some irregularity may be occurring or have occurred, in the conduct of the financial affairs of the union may take steps with a view to investigating further, obtaining clarification and if necessary securing regularization of that conduct.
