JUDGMENT

The complaint of Unfair Dismissal is struck out.

REASONS

- 1. By a letter dated 28 September 2018 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the complaint of Unfair Dismissal should not be struck out. Under section 108 of the Employment Right Act 1996, claimants are not entitled to bring a complaint of Unfair Dismissal unless they were employed for two years or more.
- 2. The claimant has failed to make representations in writing, or has failed to make any sufficient representations, why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The complaint of Unfair Dismissal is therefore struck out.
- 3. The claimant's remaining claims remain and will proceed.
