Thank you for your email of 25 July 2018 requesting the following information:

*“Could the value of the Falcon contract as set out in FOI 2015-03755 ref BAE defence contracts be broken down into the acquisition phase and the support phase.”*

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that all the information in scope of your request is held. The information you have requested can be found below. Please note we have used approximate figures.

Contract title: FALCON STEADY STATE TRAINING

The contract is all support/training. There is no acquisition of anything related to the FALCON system and while the Contractor does provide IT, this is included as part of the service.

Acquisition phase: £0  
Support phase: £7.2m

Contract title: THE DEMONSTRATION AND MANUFACTURE PHASE OF PROJECT FALCON – figures for this contract have been rounded to the nearest £1m.

Acquisition phase: £310m  
Support phase: £129m
