"I would like to obtain information regarding the current status of the Ynys Gaint MoD Facility in Menai Bridge, Isle of Angelsey and the sale of this piece of land.

I wish to know the current status, also what process was made as to not allowing public tender for this property."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD) and I can confirm that all the information in scope of your request is held.

The information you have requested can be found below:

The land at Ynys Gaint is currently owned by the MOD and is presently being disposed of in accordance with the departments standard procedures as mandated by the Treasury. In this case the best way to dispose of this land has been identified as being via private sale.
