I refer to your e-mail dated 14 August 2018, which was acknowledged on 15 August 2018.

We are treating your e-mail as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your e-mail you requested the following information:

"Please tell me how many employment tribunals claims have been made against the force since August 2013, the nature of the complaint (ie harassment, bullying, inequality), the outcome, and whether the claim is ongoing.

Please tell me how many of these claims involved/cited officers above inspector rank (I am NOT asking for how many claimants were senior officers but rather how many claims referred to the behaviour of an officer of greater rank than inspector).

Please break the information down year by year (taking the year in which a claim was lodged).

Please indicate where one claimant has made multiple claims."

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.

Please note that the Information Commissioner will not normally investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
