JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgment of the tribunal is that:

- 1. The claimant was unfairly dismissed.
- 2. The claim of breach of contract is well-founded.
- 3. The claim that the respondent discriminated against the claimant within the meaning of s18 Equality Act 2010 is well founded.
- 4. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £23,798.35 comprised as follows:

4.1. Loss of earnings to date of hearing: £ 2,392.67

4.2. Interest on that sum £ 14.72

4.3. Future loss of earnings £ 2,318.35

4.4. Injury to feelings £ 17,000.00

4.5. Interest on that sum	£	732.31
4.6. Basic Award	£	840.30
4.7. Compensatory Award	£	500.00
