## JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The complaints of constructive and actual unfair dismissal are not well founded.
- 2. The complaints of disability discrimination are not well founded.
- 3. The complaint of wrongful dismissal is not well founded.
- 4. The complaint of unlawful deduction from wages is not well founded.

5. The complaint of victimisation in relation to an event on 24 January 2018 is well founded.

6. The complaints of victimisation in relation to events on 20 and 21 March 2018 are not well founded.

7. There will be a remedy hearing on 20 March 2019 beginning at 10 a.m. with a time estimate of 3 hours. If any application for costs is made, that application will also be considered at that hearing.
