## CERTIFICATE OF CORRECTION

### Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013

Under the provisions of Rule 69, the **judgment** sent to the parties on 31 October 2018, is corrected as set out in block type at paragraph **1 as below**.

1. The tribunal declares that the complaint that the Second Respondent failed to comply with a requirement of Section 188 of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992 is well founded and makes a protective award of **90 DAYS** in respect of the Claimant who was dismissed on 19 February 2018 as redundant and orders the Second Respondent to pay the said sum as remuneration for the protected period beginning on 19 February 2018.
2. The claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment of £888.46.
