

NOTICE OF ORDER WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 SECTION 53

Rutland County Council
Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order No.1 of 2018

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is 27 December 2018

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding a bridleway (to be known as bridleway No E363) which will be 1925 metres in length from the C6305 Cold Overton Road, Langham, at Ordnance Survey grid reference SK83901077 (point A on the plan reference E363/17/1), to Ranksborough Hill at Ordnance Survey grid reference SK82171128 (point E), via Ordnance Survey grid references SK883601100(point B), SK83401098 (point C) and SK83081111 (point D), as shown on the attached map (reference E363/17/1) by a continuous line with cross bars at intervals between A and E.

Any person wishing to view the statements of case and other documents relating to this Order may do so by appointment at Rutland County Council offices, Catmose, Oakham, Rutland LE15 6HP Monday to Thursday between 9:00am and 4:45pm and Fridays between 8:30am and 4:15pm. Telephone: 01572 722577.

As Rutland County Council has indicated that they will not be supporting the order, the case for the order will be taken forward by Rosemary Harris on behalf of the British Horse Society. Ms Harris will be expected to adhere to the following timetable as if she were the Council.

Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments

Within 2 weeks of the start date [by 10 January 2019]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 21 February 2019]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 4 April 2019]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties everyone should keep to the timetable to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time. Late documents will be returned.

We cannot accept any libellous, racist or abusive comments. Any documents containing such comments will be returned.

This Order is made by Rutland County Council District Council ("the Surveying Authority") under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to the Surveying Authority that the Definitive Map and Statement for Rutland County Council District Council requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(i) namely the discovery of evidence which shows that a bridleway which is not shown in the Definitive Map and Statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist on land between Cold Overton Road (C6305) in Langham and the county boundary with Leicestershire at Ranksborough Hill, Rutland.

The Surveying Authority have consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates.

The Surveying Authority hereby orders that:

1. For the purpose of this Order the relevant date is 12th October 2017.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to this Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as "The Rutland County Council District Council (Langham) Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order No. 1 of 2018".

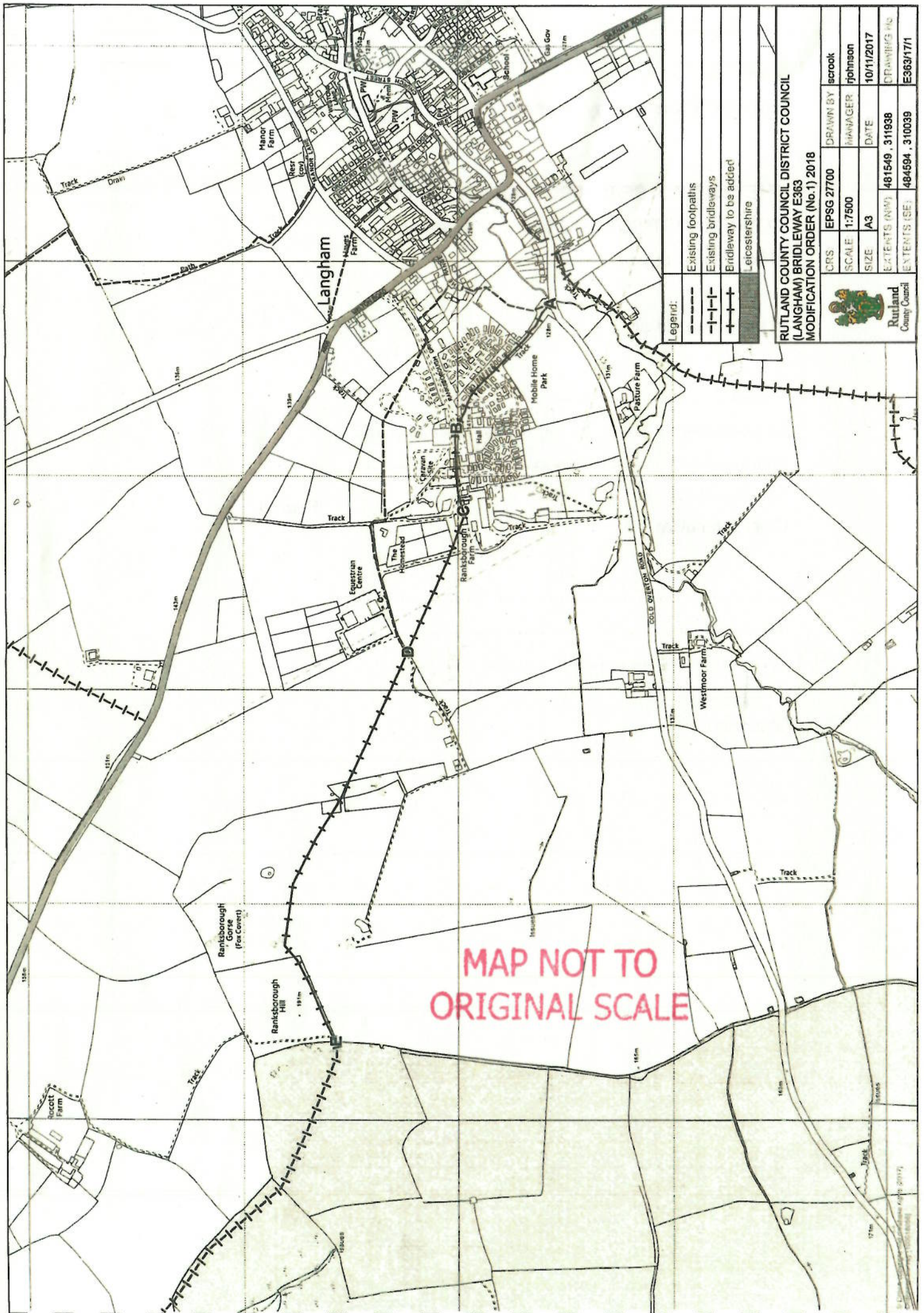
