## **Retail Discount**

At Autumn Budget 2018, the Government announced a business rates discount scheme for retail properties in England which have a rateable value of below £51,000. Under the scheme, eligible ratepayers will receive a one third discount from their bill in 2019/20 and 2020/21.

Local authorities will be expected to use their discretionary relief powers (under section 47 of the Local Government Finance Act 1988, as amended) to grant this new discount for retail properties in line with the relevant eligibility criteria. They will be compensated for the cost of granting the discount through a Section 31 grant from Government.

## Reasonable additional costs

MHCLG recognises that implementing the new retail discount scheme will place some additional burden on billing authorities, both in regards to the costs associated with the software changes and the costs of administration.

In accordance with the New Burdens doctrine, the Department has conducted an assessment of the expected reasonable additional software costs, working with relevant stakeholders including representatives of the various software user groups. Full details of the funding for the software costs (only) are at Annex A. Local authorities should ensure that they work with their software suppliers to implement the software changes necessary for the start of the new billing cycle.

The Department is continuing to engage the sector to assess the additional administration costs associated with the Retail Discount. When these are known, MHCLG will confirm the total amount of New Burdens funding that will be paid to local authorities, covering both software and administration.

It is MHCLG's intention that the New Burdens for this scheme will be paid in one payment after the administration costs have been finalised.
