## **JUDGMENT**

- 1. The complaint of unfair dismissal (and, insofar as there was such a complaint, the complaint of race discrimination) are in each case struck out.
- This is without prejudice to the complaint of unauthorised deductions of wages proceeding.

## **REASONS**

- 1. The Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to consider a complaint of unfair dismissal because the claimant does not have sufficient qualifying employment (two years) as required by the Employment Rights Act 1996 section 108.
- 2. At a Preliminary Hearing for case management conducted on 20 December 2018 the claimant explained to the Judge that he had not intended to bring a complaint of race discrimination and he was content that, insofar as the Tribunal had thought that he intended to bring such a complaint, that that complaint should now be regarded as not proceeding and therefore struck out.
