"I'm interested in the extents of training areas on the Aldershot military lands (demonstrated by plans), and the type of training that took place from World War II to the present."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD) and I can confirm that all the information in scope of your request is held.

A map of the Aldershot Training area can be found at annex A.

The types of military training that has taken place on the Aldershot Training Areas from World War II to the present includes the following:

General Fitness Training	Battlefield Scenarios up to company level
Map reading and orienteering	Command and control of positions
Defence and attack of positions including urban	Sniping
Patrolling	Ambushing
Dog training	Logistics; including fuel and stores re-supply
Radio signalling	Field hospital
Vehicle Testing	Driver training
Engineer demolition	Mine clearance
Bridging	Public order training
