# JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

2. The second respondent, Mr Bold, was not the claimant's employer. The Tribunal therefore has no jurisdiction to hear a claim of unfair dismissal brought by the claimant against him, and the claim against the second respondent is struck out.
