- 1. The claimant is claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment in the sum of £3556 (7 weeks @ £508).
- 2. The claimant's claim for damages for breach of contract (notice pay) succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant £3768.73 (7 weeks @ £538.39per week).
- 3. The respondent has made an unauthorised deduction from the claimant's wages. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant £3768.73. This is the gross amount. If the respondent pays the tax and national insurance due to HMRC, payment of the net amount will meet the judgment debt.
- 4. The respondent failed to pay the claimant in lieu of entitlement to annual leave. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £767.10.
