JUDGMENT

1. The Tribunal has jurisdiction to hear the Claimant's claim of unlawful deduction from wages, as it was brought within the statutory time limit.
2. The Respondent made unlawful deductions from the Claimant's wages, in the sum of £576 gross, calculated on her working eight hours a day, at £9 per hour, two days a week, for four weeks, between 5 March and 5 April 2018 and is ordered to pay the Claimant that sum.
