

## **Details of the proposal**

The Environment Agency is proposing to revoke (cancel) the abstraction licence numbers mentioned below.

The Environment Agency is required to give notice of this proposal. The Environment Agency give this notice under section 52 of the Water Resources Act 1991 and regulation 31 of the Water Resources (Abstraction and Impounding) Regulations 2006.

## **Details of the proposal**

Licence number 03/28/77/0049 allows the licence holder Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd, 40 Melton Street, London, NW1 2EE to abstract a total of 16458 cubic metres (m<sup>3</sup>) a year at National Grid Reference (NGR) SK 655 91 at Scrooby, Doncaster.

The proposal is to revoke (cancel) the licence listed above.

The Environment Agency has made this proposal as part of a programme to help restore sustainable abstraction and to conserve, and secure the proper use of, water resources.
