PRELIMINARY HEARING JUDGMENT

The claimant's claim of unlawful deduction of wages is well founded.

ORDER

The claimant shall set out on A4 paper, the dates the claimant worked, the hours for which she worked and the total hours claimed for each day, together with confirmation that the sums claimed are a true and accurate record of her work and send to the Tribunal on or before **22 February 2019**.

REASONS

1. The claimant appeared before the tribunal this morning and although she produced various time sheets for which she confirmed she had not been paid, she indicated that she had more evidence of unpaid time sheets on her phone. When she tried to email those to the tribunal there were some difficulty in the process and when some did get through on the claimant's own phone, they were largely illegible.

2. It is for that reason the tribunal has requested the claimant set out the dates worked and the hours worked for each day and the total amount claimed on or before 22 February 2019.
