Dorset County Council Footpaths 37 (part), 38 and 103 (part), Thorncombe) Public Path Diversion Order 2015

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is **22 January 2019**.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of a public local inquiry.

The Inquiry will be held at **Thorncombe Village Hall, Chard Street, Thorncombe, Chard, Somerset, TA20 4ME** on **Tuesday 23 July 2019** at 10.00am.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to divert the public footpaths at Thorncombe in the West Dorset District, as shown on the Order map as follows:-

From the existing paths:

Part of Footpath 37

From its junction with Footpath 103, north west of Worcester at ST 37530329, west crossing a paddock to its junction with the current Footpath 38 at ST 37510329, continuing west south west, crossing Footpath 40 and into the next field, then west south west and west to ST 37320324. (No recorded width).

Footpath 38

From its junction with the current Footpath 37, west north west of Worcester at ST 37510329, south west across a paddock and field, crossing Footpaths 40 and 39 and continuing south west to its junction with Footpath 84 at ST 37290312. (No recorded width).

Part of Footpath 103

From the unaffected part of Footpath 103, at the rear of Pennyhayne at ST 37510326, north east to its junction with the current Footpath 37 and the unaffected part of Footpath 103, north west of Worcester at ST 37530329. Width: At ST 37530329 - 2 metres.

To the new paths:

Part of Footpath 37, (to be renumbered Footpath 104)

From its junction with the new route of Footpath 103, north west of Worcester at ST 37520329, continuing north west along a tarmac surfaced path to ST 37480331, then south west between field boundaries to its junction with Footpath 40 at ST 3745503307. Width: 2 metres.

Part of Footpath 37

From its junction with Footpath 40 at ST 3745603304, west into a field to its junction with the new route of Footpath 38 at ST 37440330, west south west across the field to the field boundary at ST 37360326, then crossing into the next field to join the unaffected part of Footpath 37 at ST 37320324. Width: 2 metres. Limitations: Pedestrian gates at ST 37440330 and ST 37360326 to BS5709:2006.

Footpath 38

From its junction with the new route of Footpath 37, near the eastern edge of the field at ST 37440330, south west across the field to its junction with Footpath 39 at ST 37370321, continuing south west to the field boundary at ST 37360319. Then south west and across the next field to its junction with Footpath 84 at ST 37290312. Width: 2 metres. Limitation: Pedestrian gate at ST 37360319 to BS5709:2006.

Part of Footpath 103

From the unaffected part of Footpath 103 to the rear of Pennyhayne at ST 37510326, generally north north east to a post and rail fence, north east along the western side of the fence to its junction with the new route of Footpath 37 (to be renumbered Footpath 104), north east of Worcester, at ST 37520329, then south east to its junction with Footpath 103 at ST 37530329. Width: 2 metres. Limitation: Medium mobility kissing gate at ST 37520329 to BS5709:2006.

<u>Timetable for sending in statements of case and proofs of evidence</u>

Within 8 weeks of the start date by [by 19 March 2019]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation and the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 30 April 2019]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Inquiry must ensure their statement of case¹ is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

4 weeks before the date of the inquiry [by 25 June 2019]

The Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Inquiry must ensure their proof of evidence (together with any summary) is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of:

- i) the Authority's proof of evidence to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and anyone who has submitted a statement of case (excluding copies of any supporting documents – although none should be submitted with a proof of evidence);
- ii) the applicant's proof of evidence to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone else who has submitted a statement of case (excluding copies of any supporting documents – although none should be submitted with a proof of evidence); and

iii) all other proofs of evidence to the Authority, the applicant, everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone else who has submitted a statement of case (excluding copies of any supporting documents – although none should be submitted with a proof of evidence).

Public Path Diversion and Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order

Highways Act 1980 Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

Dorset County Council (Footpaths 37 (part), 38 and 103 (part), Thorncombe) Public Path Diversion Order 2015

This Order is made by Dorset County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpaths described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the paths should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the County of Dorset definitive map and statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

Mr Nicholas Cunningham has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path way into a fit condition for use by the public.

West Dorset District Council and Thorncombe Parish Council have been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

- The public right of way over the land situate at Thorncombe and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up on the date which Dorset County Council certify that work has been carried out to bring the site of the new highway mentioned in article 3 into a fit condition for use by the public and thereupon the County of Dorset definitive map shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.
- 2. Notwithstanding this order Western Power Distribution shall have the following rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 namely: full and free access for purposes connected to the use and maintenance of their apparatus now existing under, over or on the land referred to in paragraph 1.
- 3. There shall at the end of 7 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be public footpaths over the land situate at Thorncombe described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this order and thereupon the County of Dorset definitive map shall be modified by adding those paths to it.
- 4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule to this Order.
- 5. The County of Dorset definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order.

Footpath 38, Thorncombe

From its junction with the new route of Footpath 37, near the eastern edge of the field at point I (ST 37440330), south west across the field to its junction with Footpath 39 at point M (ST 37370321), continuing south west to the field boundary at point L (ST 37360319). Then south west and across the next field to its junction with Footpath 84 at point D (ST 37290312). Width: 2 metres.

Part of Footpath 103, Thorncombe

E – J – A From the unaffected part of Footpath 103 to the rear of Pennyhayne at point E (ST 37510326), generally north north east to a post and rail fence, north east along the western side of the fence to its junction with the new route of Footpath 37 (to be renumbered Footpath 104), north east of Worcester, at point J (ST 37520329), then south east to its junction with the unaffected part of Footpath 103 at point A (ST 37530329). Width: 2 metres.
