

NOTICE OF ORDER WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 SECTION 53

Essex County Council
Definitive Map Modification no. 639 Footpath 29 Great Sampford
(Uttlesford District) Order 2018

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is **11 January 2019**

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the Definitive Map for the area by:-

Adding a 50 metre length of Footpath 29 Great Sampford, from its junction with Footpath 26 to Sparepenny Lane South by Gill Mill.

Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments

Within 2 weeks of the start date [by 25 January 2019]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 8 March 2019]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 19 April 2019]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties everyone should keep to the timetable to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time. Late documents will be returned.

The Essex County Council Definitive Map Modification No. 639 Footpath 29 Great Sampford (Uttlesford District) Order 2018

This Order is made by Essex County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 "the Act" because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Essex requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(i) namely, the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows (i) that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way to which this Part applies.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Essex County Council hereby order that:

For the purpose of this order the relevant date is 10 April 2018.

The Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Essex shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.

This order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Essex County Council Definitive Map Modification No.639 Footpath 29 Great Sampford (Uttlesford District) Order 2018.

Modification of Definitive Map

Description of path or way to be added:

A length of Footpath 29 Great Sampford from its junction with Footpath 26 at point A on the order plan in a generally east-north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 50 metres to meet Sparepenny Lane South at point B. The width of the way is 1.22 metres.

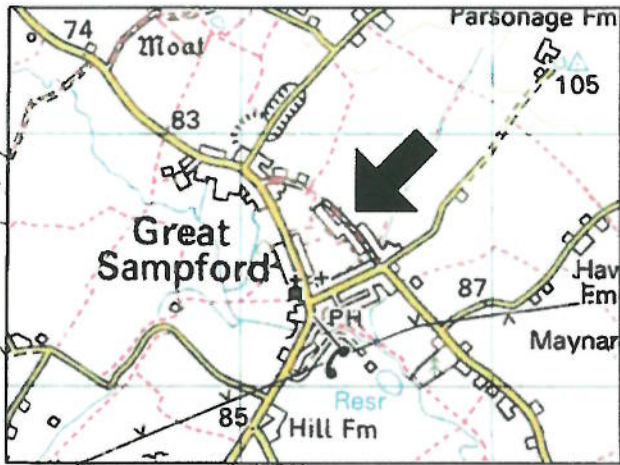
PART II

Modifications of Definitive Statement

Variations of particulars of path or way

The statement for the parish of Great Sampford shall be amended to include the addition of the following to the existing entry for Footpath 29.

OS Sheet No.	Path No.	Classification	Position and Description
63NW	29	FP	From the junction with Footpath 26 the route turns east-north-east for a distance of approximately 50 metres to meet Sparepenny Lane South by Gill Mill. The width of this 50 metre section fronting the cottages is 1.22 metres.



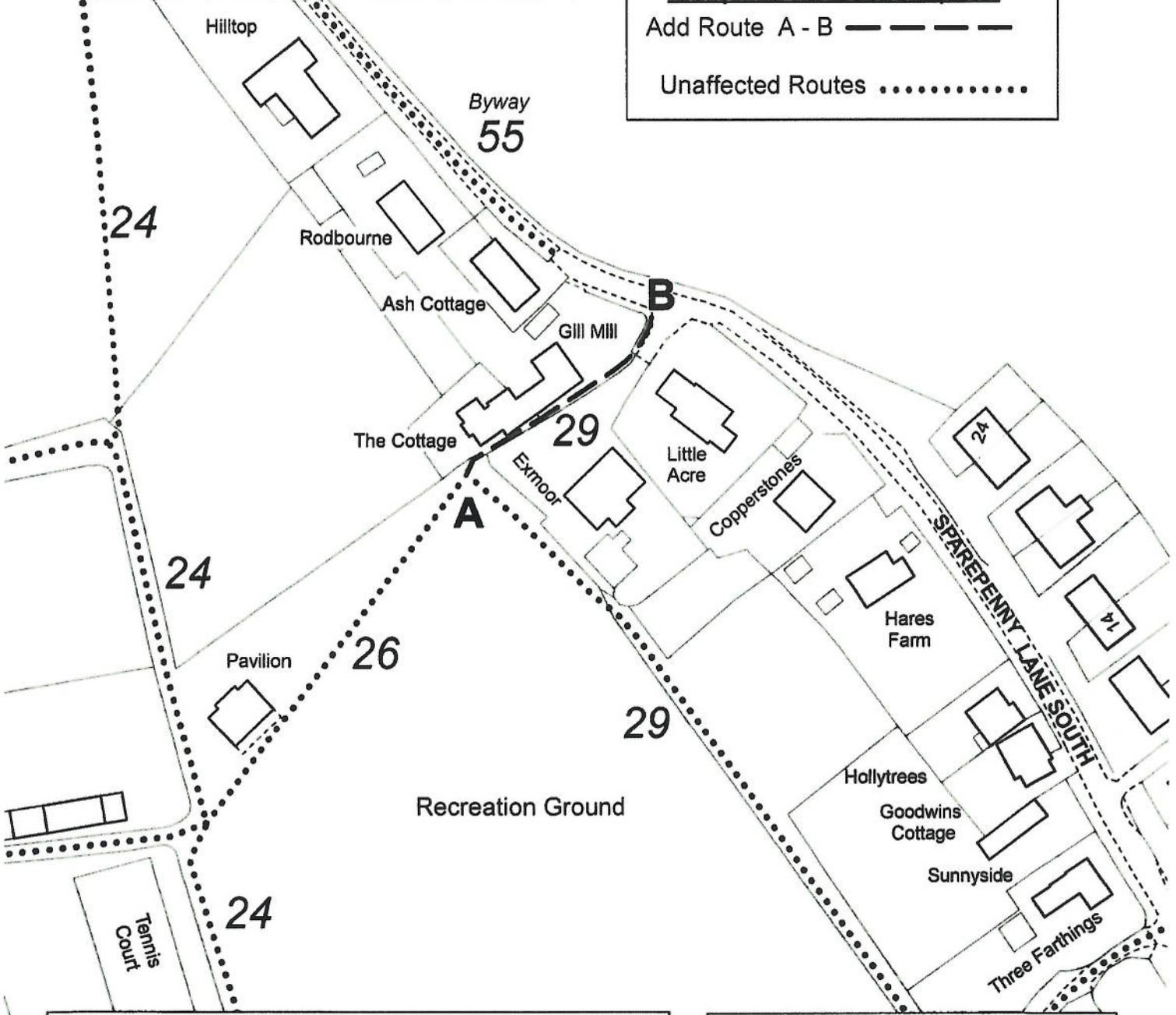
MAP NOT TO ORIGINAL SCALE
